01 SERENE

In 2011, Serene was launched straight into the pantheon of the ten largest superyachts in the world. This year, the 134m-behemoth becomes one of the most enthralling charter yachts on the planet. Her Espen Øino design incorporates 4,500m² of space over seven decks – plus two helipads and a 15m saltwater swimming pool. High-tech submerged lighting means she appears to float above the sea like a butterfly.

By day, deck five is the perfect place for alfresco dining entertaining, with a wet bar, barbecue, pizza oven and teppanyaki grill. After lunch, guests may head to the bridge deck for a dip in Serene's warm and cool Jacuzzi tubs. Come sunset, the top deck is the hottest place to host a panoramic cocktail party. Up to 24 guests – plus propitious friends – may dance the night away on the aft deck, with its two bars, dance floor and bandstand.

Despite an expansive 18.5m-beam, Serene's interior boasts an intimacy seldom found on yachts of this scale. A private elevator runs directly from the master cabin to the Nemo room, which offers an aquarium window on the ocean below. Depending on one's party, guests may partake in Serene's traditional library or a veritable taskforce of water toys. Novel additions include a climbing wall – plus a slide between decks two and three for whizzing back down.



01 ATHENA

A three-masted schooner with a fine naval trim, Athena recalls the golden age of yachting in the 1930's. Royal Huisman's build plan called for a team of 350 superyacht specialists from master craftsmen to media experts. They didn't only produce vintage elegance on an epic scale. They created the largest private sailing yacht in the world.

At 90m (295ft), Athena dwarves most modern motor boats. With several square kilometres of sail, she can outrun most of them too, without even firing her engines. She is a veteran of several round-the-world voyages, most recently in 2012 after her full refit in New Zealand. The globe seems a lot more colourful when seen from her 60m-high crow's nest.

A leviathan though she may be, Athena's timeless interior forms an intimate playground for up to ten guests. Three queen suites and an additional stateroom are wood-panelled and styled with art deco lines. The capacious master's cabin is the epitome of indulgence with a library, fully integrated entertainment zone and whirlpool bath.

Belying its dignified air, Athena embodies a go-anywhere, do-anything ethos. The water toys aft – a veritable flotilla of RIBs and towables – lie in wait to explore secret Roman ruins in Sicily or blissful beaches on Barbuda.

Back on deck, a cosmopolitan crew of 20 stand on attention to cater to every whim. It's clear from speaking with these professionals that they love their charge. Whether cruising through Capri at 14 knots or racing around the Caribbean at a maximum speed of 19 knots, they do their captain proud.

07 PANTHALASSA

When Italy's leading super sailing yacht builder, Perini Navi, teamed up with Britain's leading architectural agency, Foster + Partners, the result was bound to be bold. With a moniker than means 'all the seas', Panthalassa cuts an iconic profile from the outset.

Over 16,000sq ft (1,450m²) of pure white sail urges her hull forward at speeds of up to 16 knots. In a stiff breeze she can sail from Antibes to Elba or from Dominica to Martinique in a single day. More importantly, Panthalassa will turn heads in any port of call.

Panthalassa hosts an armada of on-board craft. A squadron of kayaks and an on-board instructor lie on hand to guide guests around the beaches of Corsica or down Venice's Grand Canal. Her new 13m Alen tender – uniquely grand in yachting terms – will cause a ripple of envy in St Barts.

Her six Foster + Partners designed cabins are spacepod-style staterooms. Each boasts rainforest showers and L'Occitane products, and are bathed in natural light.

On the stern there's a 'beach' replete with wake boards, SeaBobs, expedition RIBs and an inflatable swimming pool. The 11-strong crew can even pitch a Tuareg tent on a stretch of sand complete with campfire, lanterns and leather beanbags. For a final dose of intimacy, Panthalassa's Australian chef will prepare pre-dinner aperitivi on deck as the Mediterranean drifts by. Never have a dozen guests been so indulged.
